Reported Pattern: Fear-Based Home Confinement and Food-Tampering Threats

- Some victims have reported being psychologically pressured or “talked into” staying home through repeated threats that, if they leave, alleged gangstalkers or other individuals will break into their residence while they are gone.
- Victims report being told that these individuals may tamper with items inside the home, including food and beverages stored in the refrigerator. In some cases, victims also report visual projections or mental images showing a person entering the home or placing something into their food or drinks.
- This reported pattern appears to create fear, isolation, and home confinement. The victim may become afraid to leave the residence, attend work, go to school, seek help, visit family, or complete daily responsibilities. If accurate, this type of conduct may represent psychological coercion, intimidation, stalking-related fear, and interference with normal movement and daily life.
- This report is included for documentation and crime-analysis purposes and requires further review, evidence collection, and appropriate investigation.
