Reported Pattern: Active and Passive External Voice Assaults

- External voices reportedly directed into a victim's personal space may be understood in two categories: **active voice assault** and **passive voice assault**.
- **Active voice assault** occurs when the victim is aware of an external voice being directed from an unknown source. In these reports, victims may hear voices that bully, tease, threaten, pressure, provoke, or attempt to control them. This may force the victim into a state of fear, stress, confusion, and hypervigilance.
- **Passive voice assault** occurs when the person is unaware that an external voice may be influencing them and instead believes the voice, suggestion, or repeated message is their own inner voice. This may create confusion, self-doubt, emotional distress, or influence over the person's decisions, behavior, relationships, and daily life.
- This reported pattern is included for documentation and crime-analysis purposes. If accurate, the use of active or passive external voice interference may represent a serious form of psychological coercion, acoustic harassment, and remote manipulation requiring further review, medical documentation, technical evaluation, and responsible investigation.
